

Important Information

Where is the first aid box kept?

There are first aid boxes on all departments, and on all floors of the building. If you are in need of a first aid box, please ask any member of staff and they will direct you to the nearest one.

Who are the first aiders in case of an emergency?

We have many first aid at work trained staff. You can obtain a list of our first aiders for a specific day from our Day Manager.

Where are the fire exits?


The fire exits are clearly marked throughout the building. Included in the pack is a map of all exits to outside and other areas of the building. All staff are trained to evacuate each department of the building quickly and calmly.


Where are the fire extinguishers?

The fire extinguishers are located throughout the building and are clearly visible. They are positioned relevant to the potential fire hazard. The staff are trained to evacuate the building before tackling a fire, and then only if safe to do so.
